ADOPT AGENDA: Mayor Gibbs asked for a motion to adopt the agenda.

Donnie Potter made a motion, and Joe Wesson seconded, to give a donation in the amount of one hundred-fifty dollars (\$150.00) to the Caldwell County Special Olympics. All were in favor.

REQUEST FOR A DONATION TO CALDWELL COUNTY FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE: Robbie Wilkie spoke on behalf of the Caldwell County Fire Marshal's office requesting a donation to help cover the cost of training and maintenance of an accelerant detection canine.

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Johnny Wilson made a motion, and Donnie Potter seconded, to give a donation in the amount of one hundred-fifty dollars (\$150.00) to the Caldwell County Fire Marshal's Office. All were in favor.

WATER/SEWER AND SANITATION BAD DEBT WRITE-OFF: Administrator Eckard stated each year the finance staff looks at uncollected utility and sanitation bills for the past three years that they do not expect to collect. The finance staff has requested Council approve the enclosed list of accounts for the 2009 calendar year be written off as bad debt.

Johnny Wilson made a motion, and Donnie Potter seconded, to approve Finance Officer Karen Clontz write-off the bad debt in the amount of \$3,851.75 for the 2009 calendar year. All were in favor.

PLANNING MATTERS:

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PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCE: Town Planner Johnny Wear stated there is nothing in the Town's Ordinance pertaining to Solar Energy Systems. The Planning Board discussed this matter and recommends Council call for a public hearing to adopt the enclosed proposed amendment.

Donnie Potter made a motion, and Joe Wesson seconded, to call for a public hearing on May 21, 2013 at 6:00 pm at the Sawmills Town Hall to discuss a solar energy systems ordinance. All were in favor.

APPOINTMENT TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT: Planner Wear stated the term of appointment for Board of Adjustment member Todd Hess expires in May and he has given consent to serve another term.

Joe Wesson made a motion, and Donnie Potter seconded, to re-appoint Mr. Hess to the Board of Adjustment for the term of one-year. All were in favor.

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DOE RUN SUBDIVISION LANDSCAPING: During the 2012 Budget Retreat Council set aside \$4,000.00, from Powell Bill funds, for future replacement of the Bradford Pear trees the Town removed from the medians. Catherine Peak volunteered to be the liaison that will communicate directly with Administrator Eckard and report to the residents in Doe Run.

Joe Wesson made a motion, and Jeff Wilson seconded, to excuse Councilman Donnie Potter from voting, due to a conflict of interest as, Councilman Potter lives in the Doe Run Subdivision.

Joe Wesson made a motion, and Johnny Wilson seconded, to use the \$4,000.00 allocated from Powell Bill funds to purchase replacement landscape approved by the Towns engineer and the liaison Catherine Peak and that all volunteers must sign a liability release form. Those in favor were Trena McRary Kirby, Joe Wesson, and Johnny Wilson. Those opposed were Jeff Wilson. The motion carried by a 3-1 vote.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Mayor Gibbs asked if anyone wished to speak during public comment.

Reid Lingerfelt spoke in regards to bathrooms at the Veterans Park.

Chip Duncan spoke in regards to a previous discussion about a Town sign on U.S. Highway 321.
